Competition-1

The Traditional song and rhyme competition, being organized by the IKS Division of the Ministry of Education at AICTE, is your chance to charm your listeners around the globe with your traditional song or rhyme.

NOTE-This competition is strictly for school children from Classes 1 to 5.

Follow these simple steps:-

- 1) Prepare a short video (1-2 mins) of a traditional rhyme or song that you are presenting in your language with your grandparent or any elderly member of your family or your neighborhood other than your parents.
- 2) Submit the video with a short description of what the song/rhyme means, so that friends from other parts of the country and the world can enjoy its special sense and rhythm (Minimum 200 words- maximum 500 words).

Requirement

- 1) The length of the video should strictly be between 1 to 2 minutes, including the beginning and end credits.
- 2) The video can be in either colour or monochrome in time-lapse/normal mode.
- 3) The video has to be shot in HD format within the ratio 16:9 in Horizontal format.
- 4) The video should begin with a self-introduction which includes your name, age, class, name of the song/ rhyme and end with the credits including your collaborator and production assistants.
